<u>STEP 1</u>

STARTING OVER AT THE BEGINNING

Step 1 states "we admitted we were powerless over alcohol—that our lives had become unmanageable."

It is not necessary to relapse in order to be "thoroughly convinced" there is a problem with alcohol but when it does happen it is most likely that something was missing from our learning curve that lead to a relapse. For many it was getting away from meetings, working the steps, and staying connected to Higher Power. It could also be from not thoroughly doing our 12 steps in the first place. Everyone has their own story.

Whatever the reason for a relapse, going back to Step 1 is essential. We have to go back and realize how powerless we had become over alcohol & what a mess life had become.

From the Twelve Steps & Twelve Traditions it is written, "Who cares to admit complete defeat? Practically no, of course. Every natural instinct cries out against the idea of personal powerlessness. It is truly awful to admit that, glass in hand, we have warped our minds into such an obsession of destructive drinking that only an act of Providence can remove it from us."

It continues to be written, "No other kind of bankruptcy is like this one. Alcohol now become the rapacious creditor, bleeds us of all self-sufficiency and all will to resist its demands. Once this stark fact is accepted, our bankruptcy as going human concerns is complete.

But upon entering A.A. we soon take quite another view of this absolute humiliation. We perceive that only through utter defeat are we able to take our first steps toward liberation and strength. Our admissions of personal powerlessness finally turn out to be firm bedrock upon which happy and purposeful lives may be built."


For most, coming back from a relapse is far more difficult than coming in for the first time. It is with haste that getting into Step 1 should be done.

The Steering Committee minutes for November 13, 2017 were read. John moved to approve; Greg seconded; approved.

The Intergroup Rep meeting minutes for November 20, 2017 were read. Corrections noted.

HOTLINE REPORT: All Hotline slots are currently filled. Please continue to announce that AA volunteers are needed for the Hotline.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Treasurer's Report was reviewed. It was moved to approve; seconded; passed.

INTERGROUP REPORT:

Telephone Calls: Of the 110 total calls to our office in November, 50 were general/office; 49 meeting requests, and two 12 step calls.

BLH: BLH was sent a \$25 gift card to say thank you for their continued services. *Holiday Greeting to Cards to AA Groups:* Holiday Greeting cards were sent to all AA Groups in our Intergroup service area.

WEBSITE REPORT: Of the 1,476 visitors to our website in November, 1,155 were new visitors and 609. Marcy is in the process of entering online database for online ordering.

OLD BUSINESS:

<u>Steering Committee Group Inventory</u>: This matter tabled until approximately March 2018 after election of new Steering Committee officers.

<u>New Office Phones</u>: New phones were purchased for the Intergroup Office at a cost of \$120 giving our office more telephone features. We currently have two telephone lines; one of which has been used primarily for faxes and credit card purchases. The new phone will enable us to have two office lines.

COMMITTEES:

Finance Committee: A draft of our 2018 Financial Forecast was provided.

<u>Human Resources Committee Update</u>: Laurie H shared information on establishing a Human Resources Committee for our Intergroup Office. Deb reported that she as current acting Chair, Greg and Maureen met to oversee potential applicants for our Office Staff. Saturday (Dec 16, 2017) at 10:00 am at our Intergroup Office has been set to complete the interview process of hiring our office assistant. Laurie H and Marc T. of our Finance Committee will be in attendance in addition to Steering Committee members that can make it.

<u>Gratitude Dinner</u>: Of our \$3,700 netted from the November 2017 Gratitude Dinner, it moved, seconded and passed to transfer \$1,500 to the Prudent Reserve (making a Prudent Reserve balance of approximately \$16,250). The balance of the \$3,700 income from the Gratitude Dinner (approximately \$2,200) will be held in our Intergroup checking account to purchase and stock up on supplies, noting our Districts' Standing Committees purchase cases of Big Books from Intergoup.

<u>Inventory of our Stock on Hand at the Intergroup Office</u>: December 30, 2017 (Saturday, 10:00 am) has been set to inventory our stock on hand. The inventory process typically takes approximately four hours. Volunteers to help with the inventory are welcome.
